Essay Submissions, and Award Nomination Guidelines

- To present an award at the Founder's Day Celebration, your school must be an active PTA/PTSA and be in good standing
 - Budget, audit, membership of at least 25 members and by-laws are up to date and received by state office
 - Remittance form and \$25.00 dues need to be received by both the state and council.
- A basket or item valued at \$100 must be donated from each school for raffle. Please email council with a description of your item no later than February 05, 2019. Item should be brought with you the night of the event.
- Awards (PTA level):
 - Each school will be limited to 3 awards per school.
 - Each school will have one minute max for speech
 - Awards can be given to someone who has gone above and beyond with your PTA, students, etc.
 - Only Awards that are purchased through the Michigan PTA are allowed to be given on Founder's Day
 - You may use the attached form to order your awards. Reminder: It may take up to 4-6 weeks to order the awards from the state so order ASAP.
- Awards (Council Level)
 - The following awards will be given by PTA Council schools
 - Mentor of the Year, Distinguished Service Award and ABCD Award
 - Local PTA units may submit an essay to nominate someone special for the awards
 - All essay submissions must be received by January 25th, 2019.
 - Only one award will be given per category
 - Please fill out the attached submission/essay form and return by one of the options below. If necessary, use the back of the form or attach another piece of paper.
 - Names will be omitted from all submissions before they are judged. The committee will then read all essays and choose one individual essay for each category.
